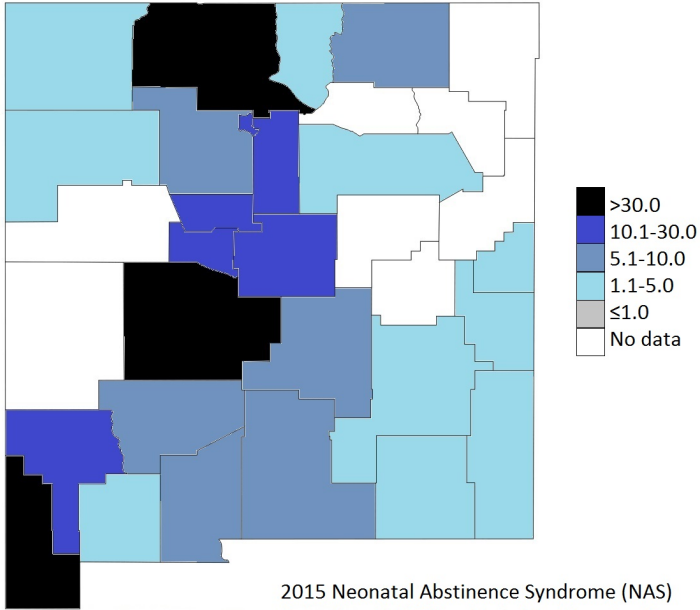


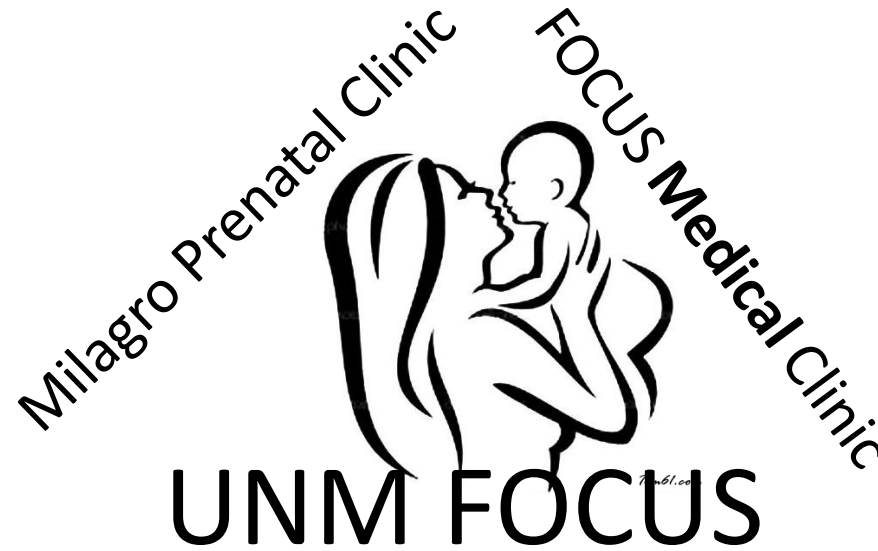
# UNM FOCUS



2015 Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS)  
Rates (per 1,000 live births) by County of  
Residence of the Mother, in New Mexico

Nationally the rates of NAS are  
5.8 per 1000 births (2012) up from  
1.2 per 1000 in 2000  
(Patrick, Davis, Lehman, Cooper, 2015)

NM average is 8.5 per 1000  
In Bernalillo it is 14.2 per 1000  
In Rio Arriba it is 64.6 per 1000  
In Socorro it is 50 per 1000  
(NM DOH, 2015)



- **Developmental Intervention:** Staff & Dr.'s specialize in monitoring & intervening for developmental needs of children 0-3 w/ prenatal exposure to maternal drug/alcohol use & caring for infants who have been treated for NAS
- **Health Services:** any biological/foster family participating in home-based FOCUS serves can receive medical care at a FOCUS medical clinic.
- **Nutrition Services**
